Increase in January export indicates improvement in economy: FIEO

NEW DELHI: Federation of Indian Export Organisations (FIEO) on Tuesday said growth in January exports indicates sign of improvement for both, the Indian and international economy. FIEO president Sharad Kumar Saraf said the monthly exports further moved northward towards positive territory with almost all major export category products showing impressive growth with signs of further revival of the coronavirus-battered economy. Effectiveness of the Covid-19 vaccines have also led to bring both life and economy back on growth trajectory with a V-shaped recovery projected not only in world trade but the Indian economy as well, he added. Mr Saraf said the government must address some of the key issues including release of the required funds for RoDTEP, MEIS and clarity on SEIS benefits, adequate availability of containers, softening of freight charges, resolving risky exporters issues and allocation of funds for NIRVIK Scheme.

Transforming Railways will transform India

NEW DELHI : Indian Railways has been in dire need of investment – both in terms of passenger and freight movement. For the first time in decades, the Union Budget not only recognizes this – in fact the Finance Minister has taken bold steps towards modernization and expansion of rail network. The increase in expenditure budget of railways by 34% demonstrates Government's commitment to 'Future Ready' railway. With a target of 100 per cent railway electrification – India shall not only have faster trains but also reduce air pollution. The Budget

rightly acknowledges that bringing down the logistic costs and transport time for industry should be at the core of governmental strategy to enable 'Make in India'. This is only possible with a robust and modern freight network. The announcement to take-up Sonnagar–Gomoh and Gomoh-Dankuni sections of Eastern DFC under PPP mode are welcome moves. Additionally, plans to undertake future dedicated freight corridor projects from Kharagpur to Vijayawada, Bhusaval to Dankuni and Itarsi to Vijayawada reinforces Government's attention

to augmentation of rail freight transportation network. Creation of these dedicated freight corridors would not only make Indian products cost competitive but also generate large employment opportunities. It is estimated that each dedicated freight corridor will replace nearly four lakh trucks and reduce carbon emissions materially. India's commitment to reduce its carbon footprint under Paris Agreement is being further displayed by focus on railway electrification with targeted electrification of broad-gauge routes by end of 2023.

Sensex zooms 1197 pts

MUMBAI: The impact of Union Budget was seen on the equity market for another day as the BSE Sensex on Tuesday surged by 1197.11 pts to end strong at 49,797.72, historic high as buying was witnessed across the board amid strong global cues. The Nifty too gained by 366.65 pts to 14,647.85. The Sensex opened higher by 593 pts to 49,193.26. It advanced by 1554 pts to 50,154.48, days high before closing at 49,797.72 from its previous close. BWF Rankings: India's Satwik, Ashwini break into top 20

NEW DELHI: After a terrific performance at the recent-concluded Asia leg of badminton, India's mixed doubles pair of Satwiksairaj Rankireddy and Ashwini Ponnappa broke into the world's top 20, in the latest BWF rankings announced on Tuesday. Satwik and Ashwini jumped 16 places to reach a career-best ranking of world number 19. The duo had outclassed Malaysian combination of Chan Peng Soon

and Goh Liu Ying in the quarter-finals to become the first Indian mixed doubles pair to reach the semifinals of a world tour Super 1000 event at the Toyota Thailand Open. In the men's doubles, Satwik and Chirag Shetty retained their world number 10 spot after reaching the semifinals at Toyota Thailand Open. Meanwhile, world champion P V Sindhu remained static at world number 7, while Saina Nehwal improved a place

to world number 19. In the men's singles, Kidambi Srikanth moved up one spot to 13th, while Sameer Verma jumped four places to 27th spot after reaching quarterfinal at Toyota Thailand Open. B Sai Praneeth dropped a spot to 17th, while Parupalli Kashyap slipped two places to 26th spot. M R Arjun and Dhruv Kapila, who started playing together in 2019, jumped 33 places to 64th in the men's doubles.

Policeman killed in accident

NASHIK: Policemen Kumar Gaikwad who was on duty was crushed under the heavy truck and killed on the spot at Wangani Fata near Peth tehsil of the district on Saturday morning. According rural police, the trailer of Raju Roadlines Transport Company was going from Nashik to Baroda via Peth on the fork of Wangani village. Gaikwad, who was on duty near the District Transport Branch, he became suspicious of the vehicle and warned to stop the truck; However, the truck driver and owner Raju Vikram Garje (42, resident of Beed) ignored him and hit him hard. Gaikwad was severely

injured and died on the spot. A case has been registered against the truck driver at Peth police station. Peth police have arrested the suspected truck driver Raju. Meanwhile, a regular mobile squad of Inspector Dinesh Bardekar stopped at Wangani Naka and took action against motorists violating motor vehicle laws. The squad had taken action against about 13 drivers before the accident took place in the afternoon. Gaikwad was severely beaten by the suspect Garje, who lost control of the trailer and dismissed the police on duty. Gaikwad was found under the wheel of a heavy trailer and died on the spot.

Police constable arreted in bribery case

Constable Shrawan Kisan Mali had demanded Rs.5,000 as bribe for helping the complainant's brother in a criminal complaint registered against

him at the Ayesha police station. However, the complainant registered a complaint with the city unit of ACB, whose team laid a trap near the Ayasha police

station and caught red-handed Mali while accepting the bribe money from the complainant, sources in ACB said.
